Dear Senator Portman:

On behalf of over 2 million members of the Association of Mature American Citizens (AMAC), I write in support of S. 2002, the Dollar-for-Dollar Deficit Deduction Act.

In 2020, spending and national debt are at an all-time high and projections show an even more rapid trend for the future.
