AMAC Members Step Up Big-Time to Work the Polls

AMAC Action launched a call-to-action in 16 key states (Arizona, California, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Maine, Michigan, Minnesota, North Carolina, New Jersey, Nevada, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Texas, Virginia, and Wisconsin) to recruit **AMAC** members to serve as poll watchers. Nearly 6,200 members responded by visiting their respective state websites to sign up to become poll watchers. We're hearing that many of these states have reached 90% to 100% coverage at the polls thanks to the actions of **AMAC** members and other groups. Because of these efforts, this year's mid-term elections are expected to experience significant scrutiny.

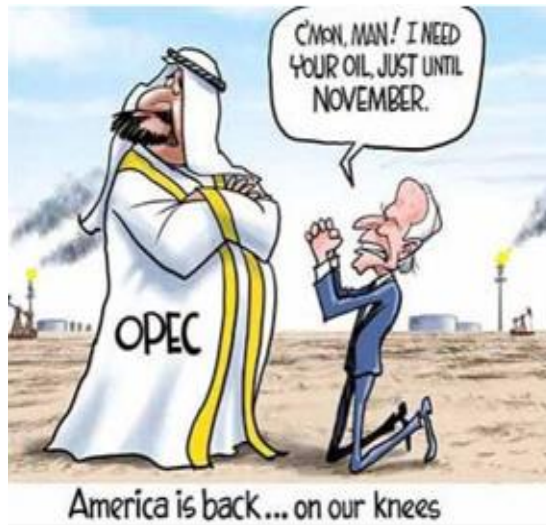
AMAC and ACRU Join Forces to Protect Senior Voters

AMAC, its **AMAC Action** advocacy team, and the **AMAC Foundation** have joined forces with the *American Constitutional Rights Union* (ACRU) to ensure that elderly voters are heard and protected. ACRU is the nation's leading advocate for the protection of vulnerable voters.

AMAC Action Supports Significant Legislation

AMAC Action recently sent several letters on behalf of the Association supporting important legislation including a bill to compensate angel families who lost loved ones due to the criminal acts of illegal aliens; legislation that protects 2nd Amendment rights from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives' (ATF) proposed registry of firearms; and a bill that would expand healthcare for National Guardsmen and Reservists.
