Social Security Myth of the Month:

Don't Claim at 70 if You Are Working

Many Americans are choosing to work longer. The month you turn 70 is when your Social Security benefit reaches its maximum. The earnings limit no longer applies after Full Retirement Age. Current earnings will still increase your Social Security benefit if your current earnings are higher than any of the 35 years originally used to compute your benefit. Money is lost by waiting past 70, so take your benefits at 70 at the latest.
