On behalf of the 2.35 million members of AMAC – Association of Mature American Citizens, I write to offer our support for your bills that would restrict the teaching of Critical Race Theory (CRT) within federal institutions, S. 2221, and H.R. 3235.

AMAC members have passionately expressed their opposition to Critical Race Theory.
